Flea Beetle Invasion

- A pesticide called "Captain Jack's" was sprayed on beds in Row 1 and 2. John Freeman and Dick Adams treated the rest with Neem Oil and insecticide soap by hand.
- Captain Jack's is a derivative of a soil bacteria and organic.
- Gardeners may water as usual and are recommended to wash their harvest well.
- Let Tana, Ken, Janie and John Freeman know if you see an infestation in the garden.

Open House Review

- John expressed appreciation for the food preparation for the event.
- The group agreed it was a success.
- It was suggested that this be an annually recurring event.
- It was brought up that not all the renters were aware of the event.

Compost Committee

- Stated that the composting system is a work in progress.
- Presented that weed disposal has begun to take over the focus of creating the compost system and that a weed management committee be formed to handle this seperately.

- New signs will be crafted with additional resource materials being made available for the committee.
- An in-person tutorial will be made an option once the system is more complete.

Volunteer Committee

- The Volunteer Committee suggests that the garden get a better estimate of volunteer hours, as this is useful in applying for some grants.
- The committee stated that a Volunteer Coordinator position could be created to oversee the projects.
- Two types of Volunteers were identified, individual and service groups. There is potential in untapped service groups.
- It was agreed upon that volunteers need to be thanked so that they will feel valued and return for more work.

Irrigation Documenting Update

- On Saturday, August 20th, a drone will fly above the garden to get an aerial picture.
