Garden Rules Agreement:

- 1. If I must abandon my plot, I will notify the garden manager within one week.
- 2. I will keep my plot watered a minimum of three times a week and every day in the heat of the summer. I also agree to weed my plot to prevent the spread of weed seeds to other areas. When dead vegetation occurs, I will clean it up and put it in the compost area.
- 3. I will harvest my produce when ripe. Overage can be donated to our local food bank.
- 4. I will not use pesticides or herbicides without written approval. If approved, application of pesticides and herbicides shall not be done on a windy day so it will not affect other plots. Organic control applications will be considered.
- 5. I will not bring pets to the community garden unless I have received approval from the managers. Additionally, I will train, supervise, and control any children I bring to the garden.
- 6. I understand my plot will be given to another with no refund and it will be a full year before I can sign on for another plot if it is taken back for any of the reasons listed above.
- 7. I understand that neither the garden group nor owners of the land are responsible for my actions. I agree to hold harmless the garden group and owners of the land for any liability, damage, loss, or claim that occurs in connection with use of the garden by me or any of my guests.
- 8. If I am unable to water my plot, I will notify a neighbor gardener or a garden manager so they will be aware of the need to water your plot. (A white board is now available for notifications.)
- 9. By signing this contract, I agree to abide by all of the above requirements.

A general meeting for the garden is held on the second Thursday of each month, from February through October. This meeting is open and encouraged by all members, new ideas are encouraged, and volunteers for officer positions are always welcome. Come meet your fellow members! It is requested that you donate time to the overall garden to help keep it running smoothly. Weeding of in ground beds, harvesting for the food bank, general clean-up, and a number of other duties are all helpful.
